

## Job Description

Job title: QHSE Compliance Officer

Reports to: Managing Director

## Main Duties:

Ensure the company complies with relevant health & safety legislation.

- Maintain and update health & safety policies, documentation and procedures, including but not limited to first aid, fire, LOLER, PUWER, risk assessments, workplace safety and COSHH.
- Create and manage generic risk assessments in conjunction with the technical services team.
- Create and update COSHH assessments based on periodic reviews of chemicals used by the engineers and electricians.
- Investigate significant accidents and incidents and implement improvements to prevent reoccurence.
- Carry out workplace audits and inspections to provide health & safety assurance as necessary (including SVT).
- Create health & safety improvement plans.
- Keep abreast of changes in health & safety legislation, new products and industry best practice.
- Periodically brief employees and the management team on health & safety best practice and safety improvements, carrying out toolbox talks as necessary.
- Update customer pre-qualification databases and work with external auditors to maintain third party accreditations ie. Achilles UVDB
- Ensure staff training is current and maintain company-wide training records.

## Maintain ISO9001 Accreditation

- Ensure the quality management system remains compliant.
- Review and update policies and procedures.
- Complete a Management Review
- With the management team, identify and document company objectives, risks and opportunities for improvement.
- Carry out audits against a self-determined audit plan.
- Develop a robust and efficient system for managing suppliers.
- Responsible for document control.
- Identify non-conformities and put together corrective actions.
- Work with external auditors to maintain accreditation.

Ensure the company complies with relevant environmental legislation

- Develop an environmental management system with a view to pursuing ISO14001
- Develop and maintain the Impacts and Aspects register
- Carry out workplace audits and inspections to provide environmental assurance.

- Keep abreast of changes in environmental legislation, new products and industry best practice.
- Identify risks and opportunities for improvement and put together proposals to the management team for approval.

## Other Duties:

Carry out assigned tasks and other duties in a safe manner, in accordance with instructions and complying with relevant DH Marine policies and procedures as necessary.
